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	<p>Students sitting level 2 exams will spend the Lent term reinforcing the essentials of Latin grammar and strengthening their vocabulary knowledge. Primarily students will aim to become proficient at translating Level 2 standard passages of Latin.</p> <p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Revision of the noun cases and their forms in the first two declensions.• Revision of the three required verb tenses of level 1 (present, perfect, imperfect)• Specific focus upon spotting and translating irregular perfect tense verbs.• Revision of the basics of adjectival agreement.• Reinforcement of Latin pronouns ego, tu, nos, vos. <p>Translation skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• This term will focus especially upon following the 'golden rules' of Latin translation.
